



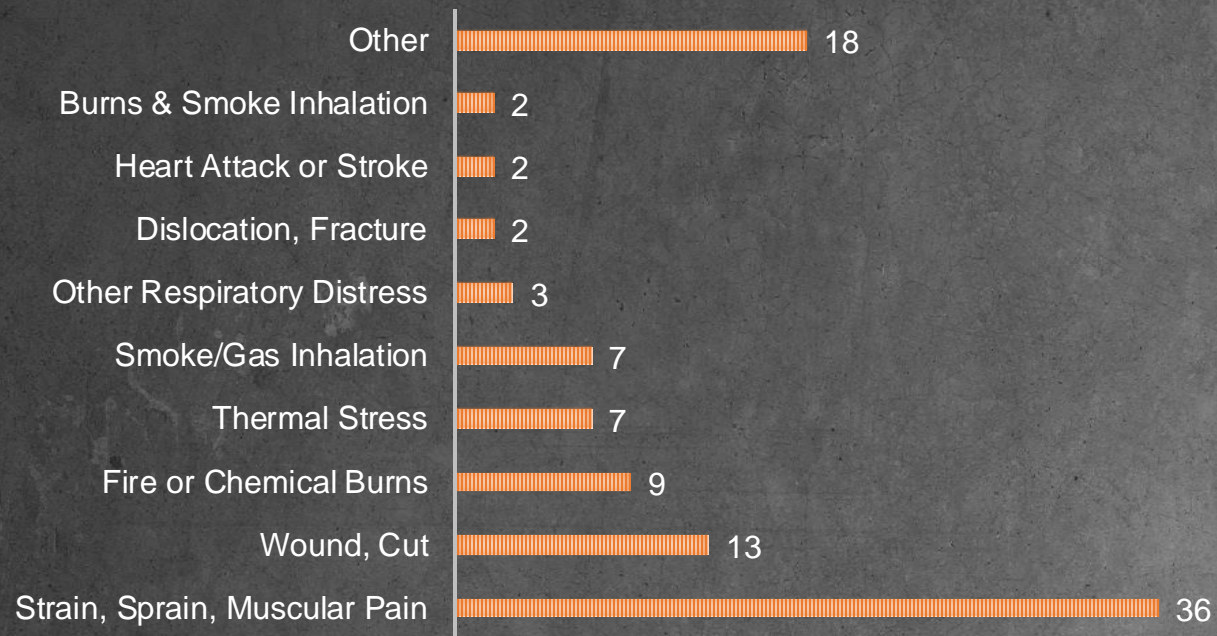

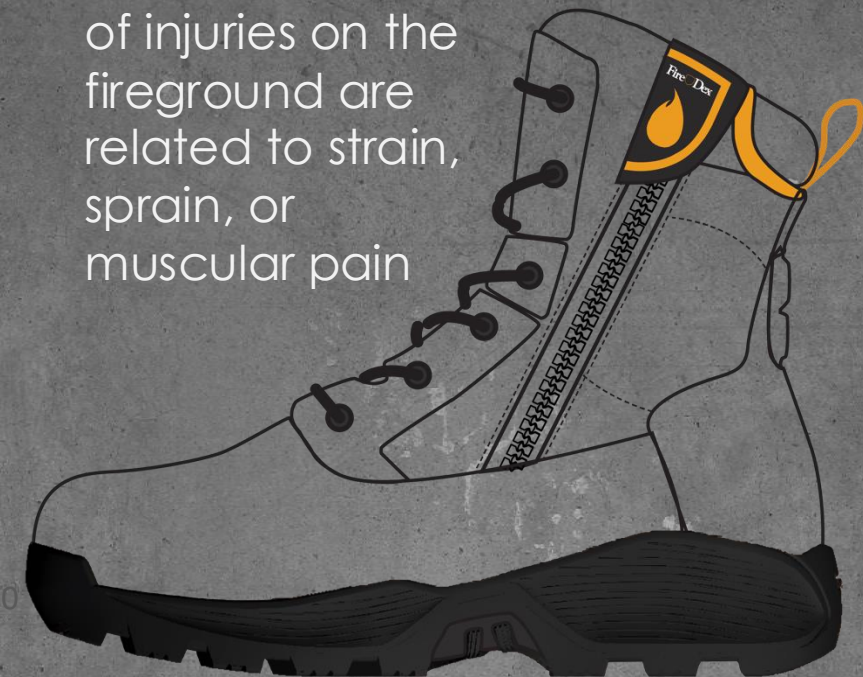

FIREGROUND INJURIES BY NATURE OF INJURY, 2022



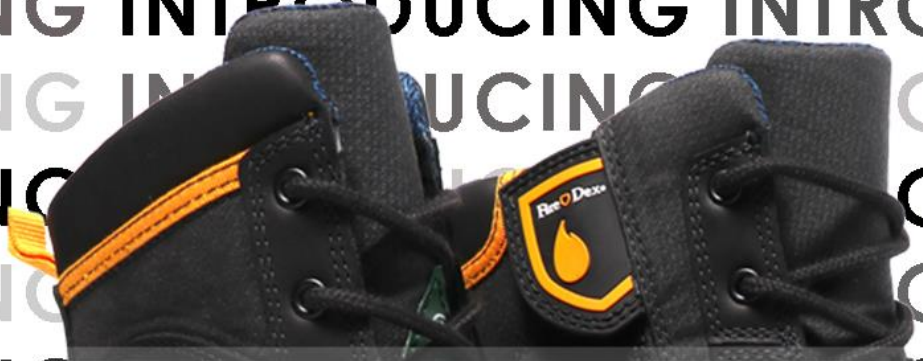

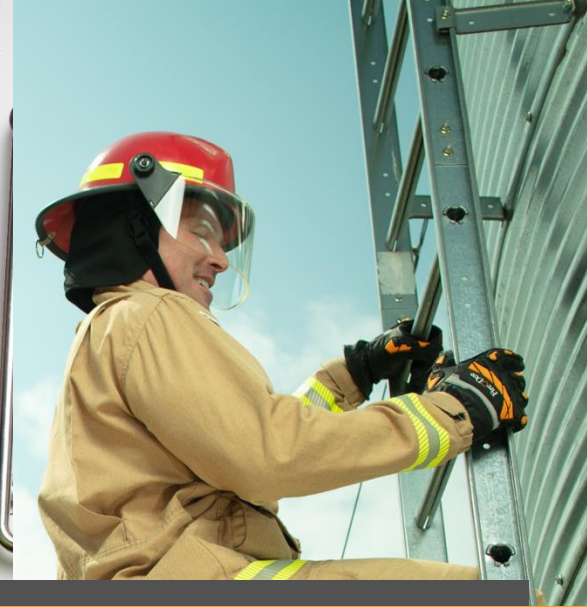
